Additionally, in order to avoid the complications that accompany a dependency on outside code libraries, the team needed to work in a completely closed environment using only the pure Java SDK.

Latin America, started with an analysis of Dapr and an example of a connector written in .net and then got to work on the Java connector. Though they weren't in the same city, the team came together seamlessly and efficiently.
